

## **ARTICLE V**

### **PROHIBITED TURNS**

*History: Adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Center Township as Ordinance 00-6-5, June 2000, as amended by Ordinance No. 2001-05-3, May 9, 2001 and further amended by Ordinance No. 2005-12-06, December 14, 2005 and Ordinance No. 2007-06-07, June 13, 2007.*

#### **§8-501. General**

To ensure public safety within the Township, the Board of Supervisors have prohibited turns on certain roads.

#### **§8-502. Provisions**

- A. Repealed by Ordinance No. 2007-06-07, 06/13/2007, §2
- B. Right hand turns are prohibited from the Butler County Soccer Association fields onto Palmer Road.
- C. Left hand turns are prohibited from Trailwood Lane onto Holyoke Road. (Ord. No. 2007-06-07, 06/13/2007, §3)
- D. Left hand turns are prohibited from Holyoke Road onto Trailwood Lane. (Ord. No. 2007-06-07, 06/13/2007, §4)

#### **§8-503. Enforcement**

This Article shall be enforced by any law enforcement agency with jurisdiction within Center Township, including but not limited to, the Pennsylvania State Police.

#### **§8-504. Violations**

Any person violating this Article shall be guilty of a summary offense, and upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine of not less than twenty-five (\$25.00) or more than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00 per violation, plus costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fines and costs, shall be subject to imprisonment for not more than three (3) days. A separate offense shall arise for each day or portion thereof in which a violation is found to exist.
